This position requires advanced knowledge of agronomy and turf grass management practices; and a thorough understanding of the rules and strategies of the game of golf. Long-term planning skills are also considered valuable as well as the ability to set priorities and adapt to a changing environment. The Superintendent will report directly to the Chief Operating Officer/General Manager.
