

The Golf Course Superintendent at The Club at Lake Sinclair will be responsible for the successful operation of the Golf Course Maintenance Department and Clubhouse Grounds Maintenance.

The Superintendent works closely with the General Manager on capital improvement projects, as well as interaction with the Head Golf Professional to maximize the number of rounds of golf played by scheduling maintenance practices around Member play to maximize efficiency. This position requires a "hands-on" style of management with a commitment to on-going staff training.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Maintains all grounds, course maintenance equipment and irrigation systems
- Schedules, trains, supervises and evaluates all personnel assigned to department
- Supervises all planting, fertilizing and care of turf, plants, shrubs, trees and other facilities on the golf course
- Supervises operation of the equipment repair shop
- Records all maintenance on course
- Prepares annual budget for department; takes corrective action as necessary to help assure that budget goals are met
- Selects and prepares proper fertilizers and nutrients for all flora and fauna
- Develops and maintains drainage, irrigation and irrigation systems
- Maintains course in proper playing condition
- Implements and enforces comprehensive safety program for employees, members and guests on course in compliance with local, state and federal laws
- Maintains accurate work records for all personnel in the department
- Communicates as necessary with golf professional to discuss conditions of facilities, maintenance plans and scheduled events
- Communicate any and all agronomic issues as soon as they are detected
- Insures that chemicals, petroleum and other controlled products are used, stored, and disposed of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. Maintains required records and strives to minimize the use of chemicals and petroleum products
- Attends staff and management meetings
- Attends turf conferences, equipment shows, workshops and other educational programs to maintain a current knowledge of technical and turf innovations and changes that could affect the department's operations
- Prepares and revises grounds manual
- Establishes short- and long-range plans for the golf course
- Oversees all course construction
- Keeps members and staff informed about current and future maintenance activities
- Conducts daily facility security checks ensuring accurate inventory of equipment and keys

- Minimum two-year degree from formal turf management program, required
- Experience with Bermuda grass greens, TifEagle preferred
- Three years as either a First Assistant or Superintendent, required
- Accomplished Trainer
